

Morningside Presbyterian Church

Our project for Morningside Presbyterian Church is nearing completion with dedication services scheduled for November 2007. Though it is evident that music was a prominent part of worship at Morningside from its organization in 1925, a pipe organ was not a resource until the completion of the current building in 1949. A new Wicks organ arrived in October of 1956. It's design still shows the influence of Henry Vincent Willis who had been tonal director for the Wicks Company until World War II.

In the fall of 2006, we were contracted by the congregation of Morningside Presbyterian Church to rebuild and enlarge their 1956 Wicks organ. In this project, in addition to updating the console with modern playing aids and systems, we will be installing all new electro-pneumatic wind chests in the Great/Choir chamber to both allow for better use of space and to provide the opportunity for tonal additions.

It has been a pleasure to work with the staff and vestry of Morningside

Presbyterian to help ensure the future of fine music for this congregation. Our firm is

dedicated solely to the preservation and care of quality pipe organs such as this one.

It is an honor to assist the church in this project.


